Le Weekend Élégant **Three Elegant Events in Atlanta to Feature Jane Seymour**

ATLANTA, GA (June 17, 2009) – Beauty Becomes You Foundation announces an elegant weekend featuring Jane Seymour and her fine art on September 11, 12 and 13th to benefit the foundation and their work, “changing the way society looks at seniors.” Three separate events are planned to pamper attendees with fine food, drink and a chance to meet the internationally acclaimed actress, author, artist and humanitarian; and participate in an auction of her acclaimed artwork. The weekend will begin with *Shaken, Not Stirred* a Friday evening cocktail reception welcoming Ms. Seymour to Atlanta. The evening also includes an exhibition and sale of her latest paintings. The public can greet Ms. Seymour Saturday at Elegant Attic in Roswell, and there is a private “invitation only” dinner party - *Blanc de Blanc* - on Saturday night, which will include a private viewing and art auction of her fine art. Attendees can celebrate Grandparent’s Day on Sunday in elegant style with *Somewhere in Time: Picnic on the Lawn* with Ms. Seymour. All events, except for Saturday’s invitation only dinner will be held at Elegant Attic in Roswell (www.elegantattic.com.)

Jane Seymour is an internationally acclaimed star of film and television known for her television series *Dr. Quinn, Medicine Woman*, which ran for six seasons and garnered a Golden Globe award. Other television movies and mini-series included *Dear Prudence* for Hallmark Channel, *War and Remembrance*, and *East of Eden* for which she won another Golden Globe for Best Actress. Her varied film roles include the recent *The Wedding Crashers*, *Live and Let Die*, and her starring role in the romance classic *Somewhere in Time*. Most recently, Ms. Seymour endeared audiences with her appearance on the Emmy award winning show, *Dancing with the Stars*.

In addition to her film and television career, Ms. Seymour is an accomplished author of eight books. She also is the designer of a special jewelry collection called “Open Hearts by Jane Seymour” for Kay Jewelers which made its highly successful debut in 2008.

Today, she is also known as an accomplished artist. Over the past eighteen years she has created an intimate world of delicate watercolors, colorful vibrant oil paintings, pastels and bronze sculptures. Her talents as an established fine artist have led way to being asked to create costume and set designs for the Houston Ballet’s production of “Five Poems” in 2001, the mounting of her first one woman museum exhibition in 2004 at the Butler Institute of American Art; as well as being selected as one of the official painters of the 2005 Torino Winter Olympics, and the official artist of the 2006 Naples Winter Wine Festival, the 2008 Beijing Olympics and

most recently the 2010 Vancouver Olympics. Her artwork will be exhibited throughout the weekend at Elegant Attic in Roswell, with several pieces being auctioned at the Saturday night dinner party.

Proceeds from the weekend's events will support Beauty Becomes You Foundation, a nonprofit health initiative embracing a holistic approach to preserving the dignity and self-respect of seniors by providing personal aesthetic care that maintains and improves appearance while lifting self-esteem. Services provided to seniors range from hair and skin care to more therapeutic interventions such as foot care for diabetics. Beauty Becomes You Foundation also provides clinicians with expert training in geriatric aesthetic health and wellbeing.
